

INTERSOC CONSORTIUM ORGANIZED THE FIRST MID-TERM REVIEW MEETING

INTERSOC Consortium organized the First Mid-Term Review Meeting of the Project „INTERconnected Security Operation Centres”. The Project objectives are: to improve disruption preparedness, resilience of digital infrastructures, and capacity building, through advanced threat forecasting, cyber-incident detection and response capabilities, at national and EU level, and dedicated training sessions in digital infrastructure security, while respecting privacy and other fundamental rights. To achieve this, INTERSOC will design and develop a user-centric intelligent threat defense and decision support platform.

The First Mid-Term Review Meeting was organized Online, on 15 September 2025. The Mid-Term Review Meeting gathered over 40 experts and professionals, researchers, technical experts, academics and industry leaders, including Mr. Ionut STOICA – The Project Officer of INTEROSC Project – European Cybersecurity Competence Centre (ECCC). Participants engaged in-depth discussions to evaluate the project's progress, share insights, and provide constructive feedback aimed at strengthening the implementation strategy moving forward.

The Agenda of the Meeting highlighted key topics such as: INTERSOC Overview; Administrative and Financial Management Aspects; INTERSOC Scenarios – Threats and Challenges; Technological Solutions; Technological Details - DEMO Tools; Awareness Campaign and Dissemination Activities; Use Cases Integration and Deployment; Sustainability Plans and Exploitation of Outcomes.

During the Mid-Term Review Meeting, a comprehensive evaluation was conducted on the actions implemented, the progress of the project, and the status of the work accomplished over the past 18 months. Furthermore, was analyzed and highlighted the project's overall evolution in terms of objectives, milestones, and deliverables, and reviewed the status and outcomes of all Work Packages, including KPIs. Dissemination and Communication activities were underlined and discussed during the Mid-Term Review Meeting, focusing on Events and Workshops performed, Communication Papers, Newsletters, Brochure and Future Plans were established in order to reach out to a broad and diverse spectrum of stakeholders as well as the general audience.

INTERSOC Project, funded by the European Cybersecurity Competence Centre (ECCC), started its implementation on 1st January 2024, and gathers 13 Consortium Partners Organizations and one Supporting Organization, from Spain, Italy, Greece, Cyprus and Romania.

The European Consortium Partners is coordinated by EXIMPROD ENGINEERING (RO) working together with CLONE SYSTEMS (CY), CEL (IT), ROMANIAN NATIONAL CYBERSECURITY DIRECTORATE (RO), ASM TERNI (IT), FRONTIERE (IT), SELENE (GR), AUTH (GR), CAIXABANK (ES), CERTH (GR), IHU (GR), SQS (RO), supported by I-ENERGYLINK (RO), as subcontracted Organization.

INTERSOC aims to deliver the tools that will improve the security posture of organizations, by pro-actively predicting cybersecurity threats and related risks, improving the detection and prevention capabilities to sophisticated threats and attacks, increasing the level of automation in incident management, while promoting confidential trust-based threat intelligence sharing and continuous training and education of security professionals. To achieve these objectives INTERSOC objective is to combine and deploy several different technologies, tools and techniques concurrently and in unison, including: **machine learning detection and prevention systems in the network and hosts, decentralized threat intelligence information sharing, collection, categorization, aggregation, correlation of structured and unstructured data, and continuous training and education.**
